Escape Kayak Tours operates in safe & favourable predicted weather conditions for maximum customer enjoyment. Forecast weather conditions can suddenly change without notice therefore it is highly advisable that all participants bring the following items to take on their scheduled tour.

Customer checklist – (to bring on the day)

- ✓ Hat or cap (wide brim preferable)
- ✓ Sunglasses
- ✓ Sunscreen
- ✓ Long sleeved shirt (preferable)
- ✓ Board shorts or similar (quick drying preferable)
- ✓ Wetsuit shoes/boots or shoes to get wet, Crocs are ok (no thongs or barefeet)
- ✓ Spray jacket or lightweight rain jacket (advisable)
- ✓ Towel
- ✓ Spare change of clothes (for after tour)
- ✓ Camera or Go-Pro video camera
- ✓ Bottled water – 1 litre preferable
- ✓ Personal medication – if required

Our fleet of kayaks are fitted with sealed front & rear rubber hatches for storage of all participants personal equipment. Small to medium sized backpacks are advised to carry your personal items. If needed, you can hire dry storage bags for a small fee - \$5 each.
